**THE FIRST—AND ONLY—PAXIL BIRTH DEFECTS CASE** During her first trimester of pregnancy, Michelle David ingested the prescription drug Paxil (paroxetine), not knowing the risks to her unborn child. Her son, Lyam Kilker, was born with serious heart defects as a result of David's Paxil use. The Tracey Law Firm represented David and Kilker against pharmaceutical giant GlaxoSmithKline (GSK). In October 2009, a jury found that GSK had failed to properly warn doctors and pregnant users of Paxil's risk. While on appeal, the case settled for a confidential amount. This was the first and only Paxil birth defect trial in the country.
